

Hitler had high hopes for his people, his nation, after the Second World War; but millions of them ended up being murdered, raped, or exiled, never to return to the Fatherand. 

By the end of the month, the <u>New York State</u> <u>Senate passed the bill</u> that was sponsored by Senators Simcha Felder, a Democrat from Brooklyn, and Senator Jack Martins, a Republican from Long Island. This legislation joins similar anti-BDS resolutions in Illinois, Indiana, South Carolina, Florida, and Tennessee.
